Cost-to-Serve Improvements by 21 %

Accuristix operates 9 distribution centers, and Rebus allows them to consolidate data from all DC's into one dashboard, one screen, and one platform. Accuristix also grants access to different departments to provide visibility to day-to-day operations and align the business approach.



Greatest Benefits using Historical Data



The greatest benefit of historical data is being able to assess how the business is changing. Accuristix can view data from a macro perspective to analyze comprehensive data in various departments such as finance, shipping, sales, HR, and customer information. Using the drill-down features allows them to analyze micro details on operational improvements to analyze how particular functions have changed over time and the overall effects. Measuring KPI's against historical data became easier and started to change due to the increase in warehouse performance due to the visibility Rebus provides. Now having access to in-depth data allows them to capture data at a micro level instead of where previous efforts focused on higher-level KPI's that over the course of a day/week could be skewed.

Accuristix granted their customers access to Rebus' visibility on their shipping orders. The most significant improvements have been focused on customer trending. Now being able to analyze data about how customers are driving their business, Accuristix built dashboards for their customers to view how much they're ordering overall, how often they are ordering the same items, and visibility into whether a product is available.

After better understanding the core drivers of the operation on the labor side, Accuristix analyzed where hours were being spent. They then compared different areas that do similar functions and measured how they were performing. After investigating, they applied best practices and quantified those impacts on operations. They found that a small improvement can drive huge savings by spending 30-40% of resources on one function. From an analytics perspective, Accuristix was better able to understand their client's makeup, operational flow, and quantify the impact of different business areas better.
